The sign does say "closed".	
BOB 1	
This is terrible! We must have missint- missun-	
BOB 2	
Misinterpreted?	
BOB 1	
Yeah, misinterpreted the clue! What'll we do?	
Mr. Moresby comes towards the Bobs	
MR. MORESBY	
Hello, gentlemen! I expect you are here because of the scavenger hunt?	
BOB 1	
Yes! We are!	
MR. MORESBY	
Well done, you two! You did very well! It's funny; I expected at least one other group to have	;
finished by now.	
BOB 2	
You mean, we're first? We won?	

MR. MORESBY

Yes, you won! And you did it very quickly too. This scavenger hunt must be such fun for you children. You know, my granddaughter Charlotte is competing in the scavenger hunt. She is going with her friends. Charlotte is quite a good listener. Just this morning, I was telling her all about the difference between temperature changes and pressure changes, which is a very interesting subject, you know....

ANNIE

Rooster barks loudly, and a man steps in. It is Old

Salt, holding a kerosene lamp

OLD SALT

Hullo. Are you looking for a boy, seven or eight years old, with an injured ankle?

ANNIE

That must be Stevie!

OLD SALT

That's his name, I think.

ANNIE

Can you take us to him?

OLD SALT

Of course. He's upstairs, where I live.

SCENE 23: THERE YOU ARE, GRANDPA!

Kim and Charlotte hurry along the street. They are heading to Jerry's Scooter Shop.

KIM

How are you feeling, Charlotte? If you want to stop the scavenger hunt-

CHARLOTTE

No, I'm fine. I'm just worried about grandpa. I mean, Mom *says* she can find him without us... so why don't we finish the last clue?

KIM

Okay....

Kim and Charlotte have reached the outside of

Jerry's Scooter Shop. Sitting on a bench outside the

store are Bob, Bob, and Mr. Moresby.

CHARLOTTE

Grandpa! Is that you?

MR. MORESBY

Charlotte! Good to see you!

CHARLOTTE

Where were you? We were so worried about you!

MR. MORESBY

Worried? Why were you worried?

CHARLOTTE

We had no idea where you were!

MR. MORESBY

Oh, it's easily explained. You see, right as I was getting ready for my physio, I got a call from the mayor's office. We were once good friends, the mayor and I, and I owed (him/her) a favour. The scavenger hunt was supposed to end at Jerry's Scooter Shop, but the owner of the shop, Jerry, had

DEVON

What happened to your leg?

STEVIE

While I was looking around for clues in the lighthouse, I fell and hurt my ankle. Fortunately, I was found by Mr... um...

OLD SALT

Call me Ol' Salt.

ANNIE

I better call Mom. I doubt you'll be able to walk home.

Annie exits.		
DEVON		
So Mr. Salt umhow long have you been living here?		
OLD SALT		
For far too long, boy. Far too long.		
DEVON		
Umm okay		
OLD SALT		
Saw you earlier today, didn't I?		
DEVON		
Um. Yes. Funny thing, I thought you were Charlotte's grandpa when I saw you.		
OLD SALT		
Mr. Moresby, you mean? Yeah, he's a good man. A lot like how I was.		
Annie walks back onstage.		
ANNIE		
Mom says she's on her way. She'll be here in a few minutes.		
STEVIE		
Okay. Thanks. I guess I can't go to the festival this year. To bad.		
ANNIE		
I'm sorry, Stevie. But next year, I'd love to have you on my team.		
SCENE 25: OUTSIDE THE LIGHTHOUSE- MOM'S HERE!		
Stevie, Annie, Devon, and Rooster are all standing outside the lighthouse.		
STEVIE		
I see mom!		
Annie's Mom walks up to them.		
ANNIE'S MOM		

Stevie! Honey, are you okay?
STEVIE
I'll be fine, I think. If it wasn't for Mr. Salt-
ANNIE'S MOM
Who?
DEVON
He was helping Stevie.
ANNIE'S MOM
Huh. Well, I'd like to meet him. Where is he?
ANNIE
I can go get him, if you'd like.
DEVON
I'll come too.
SCENE 26: WHERE COULD HE BE?
Annie and and Devon enter the room where Old Salt had been living. It looks different from
before; part of the ceiling is caved in; the fishing trophies are missing; and most importantly, Old
Salt is nowhere to be seen!
ANNIE
I don't understand. He was just here!
DEVON
He could have left through a back door but that doesn't explain the ceiling or the other changes
to the room.
ANNIE
What could have happened?
DEVON
Who even is Old Salt?
