Red's Planet, Eddie Pittman, 2016

10 year old Red finds herself kidnapped by an alien spaceship, which then crashes on a deserted planet. She must make friends, and find a way to survive. Ages 8-12 **Theme 4, 7**

Bolivar, Sean Rubin, 2017

Sybil knows that her neighbour is secretly a dinosaur, but nobody else seems too busy to notice. Ages 6-8 **Theme 6, 7**

Pathfinders Society, Francesco Sedita, 2020

Five kids investigate the history of their strange hometown, including the lost treasure of an eccentric explorer-inventor who once lived there. Ages 8-12 **Theme 1, 4, 6**

Meanwhile, Jason Shiga, 2010

A boy finds the laboratory of a mad scientist, and from there the story branches off into hundreds of possibilities in this "choose your own adventure" graphic novel. Ages 8-12 **Theme 2, 4**

Lumberjanes: Beware the Kitten Holy, Noelle Stevenson, 2014 (NN)

Five best friends are determined to have the best summer ever, even if that means having to solve a supernatural mystery and fight monsters. Ages 10+ **Theme 1, 7**

Secret Coders, Gene Luen Yang, 2015

There's something strange about 12 year old Hopper's new school. She and a new friend use their computer programming skills to solve puzzles and get to the bottom of the mystery. Ages 8-12
